## AGES 8 WEEKS TO 4 YEARS CHILDCARE

Welcome to the TREEHOUSE Snow Cubs Childcare program – our Colorado State licensed childcare facility!

**Location:** Treehouse Kids' Adventure Center; drive up level, 120 Carriage Way Snowmass Village

**Times:**

Full Day 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Half Day 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Extended childcare is available from 8am to 4pm. For reservations please call 970-923-0563

To ensure space, please have your child at the Treehouse no later than 9:30am

**Cost:** Full day: \$149      Full day with 7-day advance purchase: \$139      Morning Half day: \$99

Reservations are required. Reservations cancelled within 48 hrs. of program start date will be charged the full amount of that day's childcare. Please call 970-923-0563 to cancel when in resort.

New this year the lesson ticket is loaded onto the ski pass!

**Private lessons:** We can arrange for a one hour private lesson (one-on-one ski experience) for your child (ages 2 to 4 yrs) while he or she is at Snow Cubs. Call Snow Cubs direct at 970-923-0563    Cost: \$140/hr.

**What to Bring:** Please label all items. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

- Waterproof coat, snow pants, boots, hat, mittens
- Goggles or sunglasses
- Change of clothes (extra underwear)
- Sunscreen and lip protection
- Diapers or pull-ups (wipes for infants)
- Special toy and/or blanket, pacifier and/or bottles
- Formula, food and bottles for infants

**Health:** Your child's health is important to us. Please notify us of any health problems or medication requirements. We reserve the right to refuse any child due to illness to ensure the health of the other children.

**Medication:** If medication is to be administered, parents must sign a medical release instructing us how and when the medication is to be given to the child.

All medication must be in the original container with the written instructions from the physician clearly marked. We are not allowed to dispense over the counter medicine without a written physician order.

**Special Concerns:** Please note that young children occasionally experience separation problems. Here are some suggestions to help your child adjust to the Snow Cubs experience.

- Bring a familiar toy or security blanket, or leave something of yours with them, such as a picture, scarf, hat, gloves, etc.
- Avoid letting this be your child's first experience away from you. It is helpful if the child has learned to trust other adults (babysitters or caregivers)
- Nannies are welcome to stay in the infant and toddler areas (8 weeks to 2 yrs.). Please check with our office for rules.
- Talk to your child about how much fun he or she will have in the Snow Cubs program before your arrival. Tell the child where you will be and when you will return.
- If possible, come for a short visit the day before your reservation.

Our goal is for your child to have a wonderful experience! If your child has a difficult time adjusting, you will be contacted so together we can decide what is best for your child.
