BUTTERMILK SENIOR CAMP

SKIERS Levels 4 and above

Welcome to our Senior Camp! The 3 day clinic is designed for you – a mature skier wanting to join a group of like-minded athletes and our staff of seasoned pros for three days of coaching and camaraderie. Heads up, younger folks may be part of the camp, but our teaching approach task selection and pacing are customized to meet your needs, those of older individuals. Intermediate, advanced and expert groups may choose to travel to other mountains (based on the group's desire) on days two and three of the camp.

Location: Buttermilk

Meet at the base of the Summit Express lift.

Dates: Tuesday through Thursday

- December 13-15, 2011
- January 10-12, 2012
- February 7-9, 2012
- March 6-8, 2012

Times: 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Plan to arrive at your lesson meeting area ready to go at 9:45 a.m.

Rentals: Allow at least an extra hour if you are renting equipment the day of, or if your schedule allows, pick up your rentals the evening before your first day on the slopes. Four Mountain Sports rental shops are located at nine locations throughout the bases of our four mountains. Four Mountain Sports offers free overnight ski and snowboard transfer and storage between the four mountains

Cost: Three (3) full days: \$479

Three (3) full days with 7-day advance purchase: \$459

Extension day: If 3 or more students in your group decide to extend for an additional day (Pro approval needed) the cost will be only \$119 per person.

Includes: Lesson only.

New this year, your lesson ticket will be loaded onto your lift ticket or season pass. Separate lesson tickets will not be issued. You must have your ticket/pass to join a lesson.

Helmets: Helmets are highly recommended while skiing and snowboarding. Helmets are also required for all participants, regardless of age, when participating in Terrain Park & Pipe lessons. While helmets may reduce the severity of a head injury, the best way to avoid accidents is to know and abide by the skier/rider responsibility code.

Helpful Hints:

- Beginner skiers should consider taking Beginner's Magic
- Leave the cotton clothing at home. Dress in moisture wicking layers, even in the cold.
- Make sure you are hydrated before the lesson
- Be sure to check with your Pro and group for a great deal on extension days.
- Don't be afraid to ask questions! We are here for you!
