AGES 13 TO 17 YEARS TEEN GROUP LESSONS

Coaching happens and skills develop while teens are having fun! Daily group lessons, based on ability, can include coaching for park and pipe, big mountain, bumps, carving, racing and freestyle.

LOCATION:

Snowmass: Base of the Village Express Lift; ski and snowboard lessons available ALL SEASON, EVERYDAY!

Buttermilk: Base of Summit Express; ski and snowboard lessons available, during peak seasons only.

Aspen Highlands: Base of Exhibition lift. SKI LESSONS ONLY and must be an intermediate skier.

Available during peak seasons only.

Times:

Full day 9:30 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

Plan to arrive at your lesson meeting area ready to go at 9:15 a.m. Allow at least an extra hour if you are renting equipment, or if you schedule allows, pickup your rentals the evening before your first day on the slopes.

Cost: Full day: \$107 Full day with 7-day advance purchase: \$101

Includes: Lesson only.

Lift ticket, Rentals & Lunch are NOT included.

Teens should bring lunch money and plan on eating with the group.

New this year, your lesson ticket will be loaded onto your lift ticket or season pass. Separate lesson tickets will not be issued. You must have your ticket/pass to join a lesson.

Rentals:

If renting equipment please allow a minimum of one hour to get fitted on your first day, or if you schedule allows, pick up your rentals the afternoon before. Four Mountain Sports rental shops are located at nine locations throughout the bases of our four mountains. Four Mountain Sports offers free overnight ski and snowboard transfer and storage between the four mountains.

Helmets:

Helmets are REQUIRED for children ages 17 and under participating in Ski & Snowboard Schools programs. While helmets may reduce the severity of a head injury, the best way to avoid accidents is to know and abide by the skier/rider responsibility code.

What to bring: Please label all items. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

- Lunch Money
- Leave the cotton clothing at home. Dress in moisture wicking layers, even in the cold.
- Sunscreen and lip protection.

Health: Your teen's health is important to us. Please notify us of any health problems or medication requirements. We reserve the right to refuse any teen due to illness to ensure the health of the other teens.

Medication: If medication is to be administered, parents must sign a medical release instructing us how and when the medication is to be given to the child. All medication must be in the original container with the written instructions from the physician clearly marked. We are not allowed to dispense over the counter medicine without a written physician order.
