LOCATION:

Snowmass: Base Village Plaza.

7-9 years old meet on the plaza, 10-12 years old meet below the Village Express lift and the lift maze.

Aspen Highlands: Base of Exhibition lift. SKI ONLY and must be intermediate skiers and able to hockey stop in both directions.

Buttermilk*: Base of Summit Express lift

*Kids staying in Aspen can ride our Max the Moose shuttle from Aspen Mountain to Buttermilk AFTER their first day. The shuttle leaves the Aspen Mountain gondola plaza at 8:45 a.m. and returns by 4 p.m.

Times: Full day: 9:30 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.

Plan to arrive at your lesson meeting area ready to go at 9:15 a.m.

Rentals: Allow at least an extra hour if you are renting equipment, or if your schedule allows, pickup your rentals the evening before your first day on the slopes. Four Mountain Sports rental shops are located at nine locations throughout the bases of our four mountains. Four Mountain Sports offers free overnight ski and snowboard transfer and storage between the four mountains.

Cost: Full day: \$107 Full day with 7-day advance purchase: \$101

Includes: Lesson and lunch.

Lift tickets and rentals are NOT included.

New this year, your lesson ticket will be loaded onto your lift ticket or season pass. Separate lesson tickets will not be issued. You must have your ticket/pass to join a lesson.

Helmets: Helmets are REQUIRED for children ages 17 and under participating in Ski & Snowboard Schools programs. While helmets may reduce the severity of a head injury, the best way to avoid accidents is to know and abide by the skier/rider responsibility code.

What to bring: Please label all items. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

- Waterproof coat, snow pants, boots, hat, and mittens.
- Leave the cotton clothing at home. Dress in moisture wicking layers, even in the cold.
- Goggles or sunglasses
- Sunscreen and lip protection.

Health: Your child's health is important to us. Please notify us of any health problems or medication requirements. We reserve the right to refuse any child due to illness to ensure the health of the other children.

Medication: If medication is to be administered, parents must sign a medical release instructing us how and when the medication is to be given to the child. All medication must be in the original container with the written instructions from the physician clearly marked. We are not allowed to dispense over the counter medicine without a written physician order.

Our goal is for your child to have a wonderful experience! If your child has a difficult time adjusting, you will be contacted so together we can decide what is best for your child.
