NON-BEGINNER

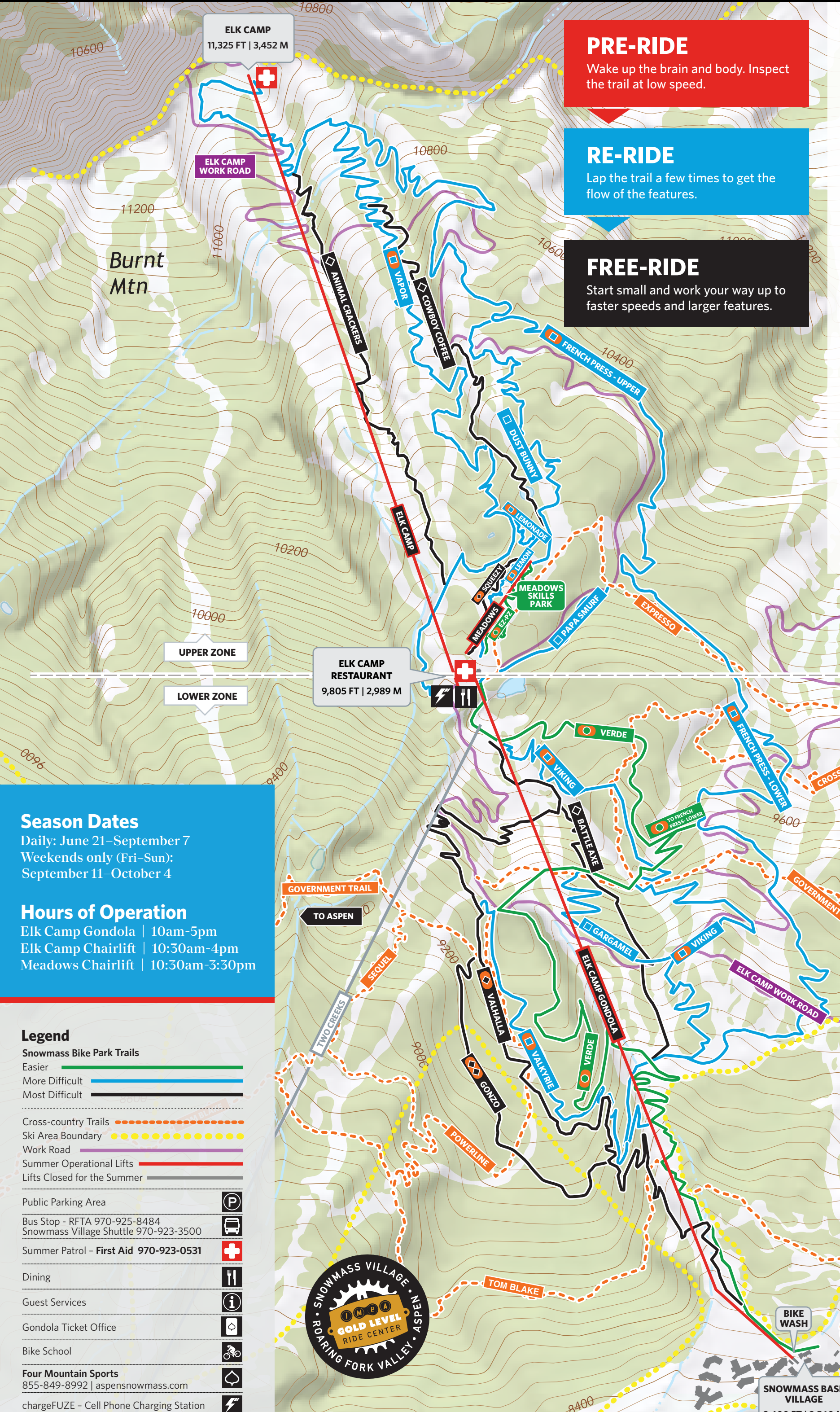
Freeride trails are machine-cut and contain man-made features. Routes are enhanced with dirt jumps, ride-on features, gaps, narrow surfaces, wallrides, berms, and other natural or constructed features. All freeride trails are identified with an orange oval.

TECHNICAL
NON-BEGINNER

Technical trails are built by hand and tend to be more natural, featuring rocks and roots. Man-made features may be encountered. These trails are typically narrower and singletrack.

MEADOWS SKILLS PARK
BEGINNER FREERIDE

An entry-level area made up of three freeride trails—EZ-PZ, Lemon, and Squeezy—featuring easy-to-handle rollers, jumps, and berms at short intervals. It's a low-stress, low-commitment way for new riders to acquaint themselves with the equipment and techniques unique to park riding.



PRE-RIDE
Wake up the brain and body. Inspect the trail at low speed.

RE-RIDE
Lap the trail a few times to get the flow of the features.

FREE-RIDE
Start small and work your way up to faster speeds and larger features.
