MULTI-DAY CAMPS

Please note: The multi-day camps listed below require reservations and often sell out in advance.

MOUNTAIN SKILLS CAMP

Ages 6 - 10 | 2-day camp | July 11-12, July 18-19, August 1-2, August 8-9, August 15-16

Campers develop skills to become mountaineering-bound kids! Campers head out of Base Camp (Treehouse) first thing in the morning and spend the entire day on-mountain. Activities include rock climbing, campfire cooking orienteering scavenger hunts, outdoor art (including paintball art), and team building skills. Campers must sign up for entire 2 days.

INTRODUCTION TO MOUNTAIN BIKING CAMP

Ages 6 - 9 | 2-day camp | June 18-19, July 9-10, July 30-31

Two day camp designed for children that know how to ride a bike and want to learn new skills. Camp will include bike handling skills, skill development, bike safety, bike maintenance, and distance riding. The goal of this program is take those children who already know how to ride a bike and prepare them for mountain biking without jumping straight into full on downhill mountain biking. It's like wading into the shallow end of the pool versus diving into the deep end that is downhill mountain biking! Come test the waters with us and learn these lifelong skills that will make each individual a better biker. (Bike rental not included.)

- Day 1 consists of skill development and improvement
- Day 2 consists of a field trip to bike and apply these skills (i.e. Rio Grande Trail)
- Campers must sign up for the entire 2 days
- Please note that featured daily activities are just part of the camper day. Other activities may include gondola rides, eurobungy, hiking, crafts, cooking or climbing wall

DIRT DAWG PRO MOUNTAINBOARD CAMP

Ages 6 & up | 3-day camp | July 24-26* *Dirt Dawg Mountainboard Competition July 26 at 2:30pm, all ages welcome.

Campers learn mountainboard skills from professional mountainboard Pro's Jereme Leafe and Kody Stewart alongside our talented camp coaches. Includes mountainboard and all safety gear. *All children ages 17 & under will need to complete an activity waiver signed by parent or guardian.* Mountainboard Competition: FREE to all participants! Family and friends are invited to watch!

OVERNIGHT CAMPOUTS

Ages 6 - 12 | July 17, July 31, August 14

Based out of the Treehouse Kids Adventure Center, kids will spend the night at our private campsite on Snowmass Mountain. Campers depart from the treehouse at 5pm and return at 9am the next morning. Overnight includes transportation, tents, sleeping bags, dinner, campfire with s'mores, and breakfast. Camper will need warm clothes and overnight essentials. Campers can attend day camp both days in addition to the overnight, daily camp rates apply.

Camp Aspen Snowmass ventures up the Elk Camp Gondola for a day of riding the Breathtaker Alpine Coaster* and scaling the climbing wall. Additional activities include hiking, arts and crafts, and more. Closed-toe shoes required. Campers must meet the height and weight requirements to ride the Alpine Coaster.

LOST FOREST FULL CAMP

Campers must be 70+ pounds & at least 48 inches tall | Mondays, Tuesdays & Thursdays, 9am - 3pm

Camp Aspen Snowmass takes to the Treeline Challenge Course* in the Lost Forest! Campers spend the day at the top of the Elk Camp Gondola challenging themselves, developing trust, and building relationships on the ropes course and through additional team building activities. Additional activities include the climbing wall, Breathtaker Alpine Coaster, hiking, and more. Closed-toe shoes required. Campers must meet the height and weight requirements to participate in the Challenge Course.

RATES

Camp is \$148 per day/per camper. Kids with the Camp Validation Pass (\$260 before 5/31, \$335 after 5/31) pay the validation rate of \$74 per day/per camper. Season Pass campers pay no fee for daily camp activities including specialty multi-day camp - season pass rate for Overnight Campout is \$74 per camper. Mountainboard equipment is included in the daily rate; downhill mountain bike equipment rental is NOT included in daily rate.

CAMP HOURS

Monday - Friday, 8am – 4pm.

AGE GROUPS

Camp activities are organized in age appropriate groups. Children ages 1 to 2 yrs. old must be walking. Children 3 to 4 yrs. old must be potty-trained or they will be placed in the Cubs Camp program. Children must be the appropriate age by the start of their program.

LOCATION

Treehouse Kids' Adventure Center in Snowmass Base Village. Free 30 minute parking available at drop off location and free all day parking is available in the parking garage.

MORNING DROP-OFF

Aspen: Drop-off between 8-8:30 am at Koch Park (on the corner of South Garmisch and East Durant). Children must be 4 years old to ride the bus. No exceptions due to licensing.

Snowmass: 8 -9 am at the Treehouse in Snowmass Base Village

AFTERNOON PICK UP

Aspen & Snowmass: 4 pm at locations listed above. Inquire about late pick-up arrangements.

LUNCH

Included for Ages 1-2 yrs. NOT Included for Ages 3 - teen. Children may bring own lunch (must be nut-free) or purchase at camp for \$12. Children 8 yrs and up enrolled in biking may be able to purchase lunch at the Snowmass Mall or Base Village and should bring cash. Lunchtime is supervised by camp staff and we request children do not bring more than \$20. Kids participating in Lost Forest can purchase lunch at Elk Camp.

WHAT TO BRING

Dress appropriate for scheduled activities. Please label everything. Make sure to include proper footwear for hiking and outdoor activities, waterproof jacket, hat, water bottle, swimsuit & towel (bring every day in case you decide to swim). Please provide a change of clothes for young campers.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

Parents must complete a Camp Aspen Snowmass medical release form and copy of all immunization records for each child participating in camp, sign campers in and out daily with camp staff, provide a daytime contact phone number, end of day pickup location and any special requests. Parents must have their Camp Aspen Snowmass issued security pass for pickup.

MEDICATIONS WHILE AT CAMP

All medication must be in the original container with child's name and written instructions from the physician clearly marked. We are not allowed to dispense over the counter medicine without a written physician order. If your child has an allergy action plan, please bring to Camp on the first day.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cubs Camp and daily camp reservations must be canceled by 3 pm on the day prior to attending camp for a full refund. Specialty programs such as biking, rafting, field/road trips, Rocket Camp, overnights, and private adventures must be canceled at least 48 hours in advance for a full refund. Camp passholders will be charged \$74 if daily camp reservations are not cancelled.

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Camp activities that are cancelled due to weather by Camp Aspen Snowmass will be rescheduled and/or refunded. Campers will choose another activity for the day if any activity is cancelled.
